Sta-Lok products were used during the re-rig of Mariella, a beautiful sail yacht originally built by Fife in 1938.






Sta-Lok's Supajust Turnbuckles support and tension the infill cables that span the Millennium Bridge in Central London.



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STA-LOK SELF-FIT

MADE BY STA-LOK. FITTED BY YOU.

The Sta-Lok Self-Fit was our originating product and it is a great testament to our founder, Ivor Barfield and his design, that in 50 years the Sta-Lok Self-Fit design has not been greatly altered.

Now recognised around the world, the Sta-Lok system is a simple mechanical method of terminating stainless steel wire ropes by hand, using very basic hand tools.

Manufactured from high specification stainless steels, our self-fit terminals are designed for right hand and left hand lay, stainless steel 1x19, 7 strand and Compacted strand wire rope from 3mm - 26mm (1/8" - 1").

Different Sta-Lok wedges are provided for the various constructions of wire and are laser marked for identification purposes.

Please note - new wedges must be used if re-terminating wire rope.

The termination is designed to be stronger than the rated breaking load of the wire rope we recommend.

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SWAGE TERMINALS.

Our stainless steel swage terminals have been designed for use with 1×19, 7×19, 7×7 and compacted strand stainless steel wire rope and can be installed using both rotary & fixed die swaging machines.

We have developed a wide selection of swage products to suit all masts, spreaders and chainplates for metric and inch wire rope from 3mm (1/8") to 26mm (1"). Designed with 10 x D hole depths for greater grip and high breaking loads.

Sta-Lok Swage fittings require professional swaging onto wire rope and are not designed for hand crimping.





FORGED BRONZE
TURNBUCKLES.

Our ever-popular Sta-Lok Bronze Turnbuckles have grown to become one of the leading turnbuckles found on yacht standing rigging worldwide.

Forged and machined from high strength bronze alloy and finished in highly polished chromium - The aerodynamic design of this turnbuckle provides one of the strongest and most elegant bronze turnbuckles on the world market today.

The forging process offers superior strength advantages in comparisons against alternative manufacturing processes, including casting.

Our range of Bronze Turnbuckles are available with 1/4" - 3/4" UNF threads and can be combined with a wide range of our stainless steel end fittings, for wire sizes up to and including 12mm.

SUPAJUST TURNBUCKLES.

The beautiful aesthetics and exceptional performance of the Supajust Turnbuckle carries all the hallmarks of Sta-Lok design and engineering.

Our premium range turnbuckles are machined from high specification solid stainless steels and feature permanently sealed threaded bronze inserts in each end.

Providing distinct advantages over other turnbuckles on the market, the Supajust turnbuckle is designed to ensure superb adjustment, even under high load, without the risk of seizing or galling.

Supajust turnbuckles are available with 3/8" - 13/8" UNF threads, with a wide range of end fittings for wire rigging from 5mm (3/16") to 26mm (1").

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The main body of the Sta-Lok Insulator consists of an ingenious stainless steel assembly which is embedded in a black weather-proof nylon moulding, designed to exceed the breaking load of the backstay.

Backstays are used as it is the longest single length of wire on the boat. Industry guidance is that the wire between insulators should be a minimum of 7 metres, with the first insulator situated above head height to avoid touching while transmitting.

Insulators should not be used with hydraulic backstay adjustors.
